Abstract: - *This article is based on the research conducted for studying metamorphosis of library and information science schedule of DDC from 15th to 23rd edition. For the present paper schedule for 025 'Administration' is covered.*

This paper discusses the evolution in Library and Information Science of Dewey Decimal Classification editions for the notation 025 from the perspective of new terminology, assigned and unassigned new subject and expanding the new notations and auxiliary structure. The paper explains the comparative analysis in Library and Information Science of DDC from 15th to 23rd editions in class number 025 to 025.999. In addition, paper analyze notations from all ten sub division and determines the meaning of every semantic atom contained in LIS i.e class no 025 to 025.999.

Keywords : DDC, Dewey Decimal, Classification, Library Classification, Library and Information Science.

Introduction

The Dewey Decimal Classification (DDC) system is a general knowledge organization tool that is continuously revised to keep pace with knowledge. The system was conceived by Melvil Dewey in 1873 and first published in 1876. The DDC is published by Forest Press, which in 1988 became a division of OCLC Online Computer Library Center, Inc. The Dewey Decimal Classification is the most widely used library classification system in the world. It is used in

more than 138 countries and has been translated into over 30 languages.

In the DDC, the notation is expressed in Arabic numerals. The notations give both the unique meaning of the class and its relation to other classes. The notation provides a universal language to identify the class and related classes regardless of the fact. The different words or language may be used to describe the class.

DDC is the example of enumerative classification scheme. An enumerative classification scheme is a

scheme where all the possible classes are enumerated according to certain characteristics. There is a top down approach whereby a series of subordinate classes are produced and where both simple and complex subjects are listed.

Objectives of the Study

- ❖ To Study Library & Information Science Schedule of Dewey Decimal Classification scheme from 15th edition to 23rd edition.
- ❖ To Study how the schedule has developed over various editions in respect of LIS terminology as well as notation.
- ❖ To identify the concepts from LIS schedule which became obsolete.
- ❖ To identify the new concepts which have been added to LIS schedule from time to time.
- ❖ To study changes in the notation in these editions.

Horizontal Analysis of the above table:

025 to 025.099 notations have been developed year by year. There is only one term in the 15th ed. Whereas 16th to 18th edition added one more term as a 'technical process'. 19th to 22nd edition has four terms and it is increased upto ten in the 23rd ed. It also come under 'technical process'.

In class number 025.1 to 025.199, in 15th ed it has eleven terms, four terms have been added in the 16th ed, one term added again in the 17th edition and in 18th ed one term was removed. In 19th ed they added many new terms upto twenty six but suddenly it decreased to five in the 20th ed. Ans remained same five for 21st, 22nd and 23rd ed. These terms were introduced as 'Administration' and included all terms.

Notation 025.2 to 025.299 introduced a new term 'Acquisition' in 15th ed and its continue upto 18th ed. Then they change the term 'acquisition' to 'acquisition and collection development' in the next five consecutive editions i.e. 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd and 23rd ed. Twelve to Thirteen terminology are available in the same editions.

025.3 to 025.399 notation is also important as the other notations. 'Cataloguing' is covered in this section which has Six terms shown in the 15th to 18th ed. Nine new terminology has been added in the 19th ed whereas twenty seven terms have been added in 20th ed which is highest amount of terms introduced in this section. And one terms got removed from 21st to 23rd editions.

025.4 to 025.499 class number starting

with the term 'classification'. There are two terms in the 15th ed, one term has been added in 16th and 17th ed and one more term added in the 18th ed. Total Sixteen terms got assigned in the 19th and Seventeen in 20th ed to 22nd edition. Twenty one terminology seen in the 23rd ed. It means new terms has been added in the same.

025.5 to 025.599 notations initiated with 'Reference service' where only one term found in 15th ed. It has been added two new terms as 'service to reader' and 'adult reader service' as a sub term of reference service in the 16th ed. Five terms has been introduced in the 17th and 18th ed where Nine terms included in 19th to 23rd ed which comes under 'services to user'.

025.6 to 025.699 class number continue with only one term that is 'circulation service' from the 15th ed to 23rd ed. It is the only term that has been introduced in 1951 in 15th ed and still continue in 23rd edition in 2011 with adding 'interlibrary loan' in notation 025.62.

025.7 to 025.799 have only one term but it has changed time to time. Binding, Repair terms were used in 15th edition but in the 16th edition we started referring it as 'bookbinding', 'book repair' in. 'Binding and repair services' introduced in the 17th and 18th edition, again which is

changed in 19th to 23rd edition as 'physical preparation for storage'.

025.8 to 025.899 class number have one term 'Arrangement, Preservation' in 15th edition and it is changed in the 16th edition as 'Book arrangement and preservation' with adding two more term 'inventory' and 'preservation'. In the 17th and 18th edition discovered 'maintenance and preservation collection' with one more term added as 'Arrangement' in the same edition. Two new terms has been added from 19th to 23rd edition referred as 'Security against theft and other hazards'.

025.9 to 025.999 class obsolete from the 15th edition whereas it started one term in 16th edition and continue upto 18th edition. Again it discontinued from the 19th edition till 23rd edition.

Vertical Analysis of the above table:

We can observe that 15th edition has one term for 025. to 025.099 and Eleven terms are available in 025.1 to 025.199. It means they covered most of the part of 'Administration'. Class no. 025.2 to 025.499 have covered Three, Six and Two terms respectively. 025.5 to 025.899 added only one term in each hierarchy.

In 16th edition has been changed from 'administration' to 'library management and operation' in notation 025. Two terms having in 025 to 025.099 and it is extended upto fifteen in

the next hierarchy i.e. 025.1 to 025.199. Seven terms has introduced in 025.2 to 025.299 while earlier terms were three in the 15th edition. Six terms are shown in the 025.3 to 025.399 which is decreased upto three in the next two consecutive hierarchies. Only one term are available in next two sub division i.e. 025.6 to 025.799. Two more terms are added in the 025.8 to 025.899 and introduced new one terms in the next level.

In 17th edition has given two terms in 025 to 025.099 and it is expanded till sixteen in the next subdivision. Five terms are shown 025.2 to 025.299 where earlier were seven terms for the same class number. 025.3 to 025.499 having six and three terminologies respectively. Five terms are introduced in the next hierarchies, i.e 025.5 to 025.599. Only one term has been added in 025.6 to 025.799 and it is expanded upto four terms in another level. One term is for 025.9 to 025.999.

Two terms are available in the 18th edition which is introduced as 'library operation and technical process' in 025 to 025.099. Fifteen terms added for the term 'administration' in 025.1 to 025.199. Five, Six, Four and Five terminologies has been released in 025.2 to 025.599 and only one terms given in the next level. Four terms allotted to 025.9 to 025.999 in the same edition.

19th edition was the most advanced schedule in the 1979 because they introduced so many new terms in the same edition. The term started with the 'library operations' having three

more terms in the class number 025.099, where twenty six terms had in the next hierarchies. It is shows that almost double in compare to earlier editions. And the same situation was available in another four consecutive hierarchy i.e 025.2 to 025.599.

In the 20th edition four terms has been taken under the term 'operation of libraries, archives, information centers' in class number 025.0 to 025.099. Five terms has been introduced in the next level and added seven more terms in the 025.2 to 025.299. Forty two terms allotted to the class number 025.3 to 025.399 which is highest number of terms has been added for the same number. One more term included for the 025.4 to 025.499 in 20th edition than earlier edition. Nine terms has been introduced for the class number 025.5 to 025.599 and the remaining are same as well as 19th edition.

Over all analysis (vertical and horizontal)

025 to 025.999 have started the term 'administration in the 15th edition, total twenty seven terms found in this edition and total forty two terms found in the next edition, it means fifteen terms has been added in the 16th edition which was started with the term 'library management and operation'. We have observe that the term administration was given in 1951 and it is changed time to time according to information era. Forty four terminologies added including two new terms in 17th and 18th edition in compare to

16th edition, one is 'to individuals' in 025.542 and 'to group' in 025.543. Both terms are narrower terms of 'reader advisory service.

We have noticed that Eighty Nine terms have been introduced in 19th edition which was more than double in compare to previous edition. In the 19th and onward edition 025.999 notation have been obsolete. We found that 19th edition have so many new terms have been added which is published in 1979. This is the indication of development of schedule for new subject or emerged new terminology in this era.

Total Ninety Five terms have been added in 20th, 21st and 22nd edition for the class number 025 to 025.999. There are six new terms added than earlier edition even the major changes happened in 025.3 to 025.399 in the same editions. Previous edition have fifteen terminologies where it is increased forty two terms and this is the biggest number in all 9 editions from entire 025 class number.

23rd edition is the most advanced and updated edition, most of the terminology have been covered in class number 025 to 025.999. for example : websites, search engines, world wide web etc. Total 106 terms are available which is highest number of terms in compare to all over edition in library and information science in the same hierarchy.

Methodology

Schedule from 15th revised edition which was published in 1952 to 23rd edition in 2011 has been studied

- The portion was specially selected for the study because it is the longest schedule of library and information science.
- A systematic methodology is required for undertaking scientific research work.
- Data collection for this study is mainly based on availability of DDC volumes for

library science.

- The research papers, articles published in various journals, proceedings, online and offline sources has been used for the study.

Two examples given for a drastically changes happened in these two class numbers.

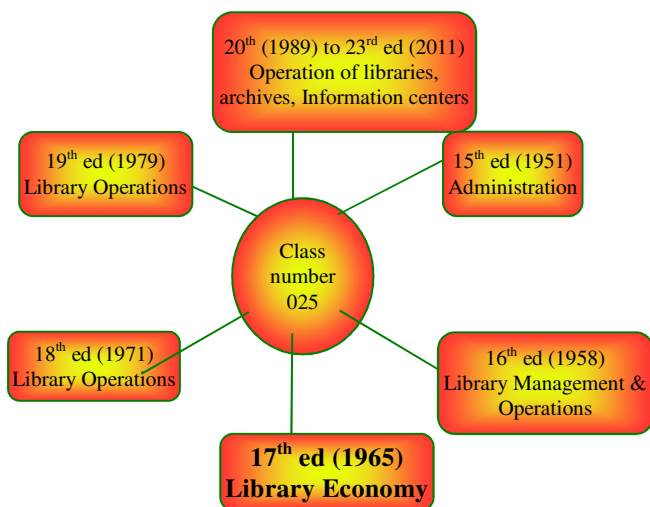
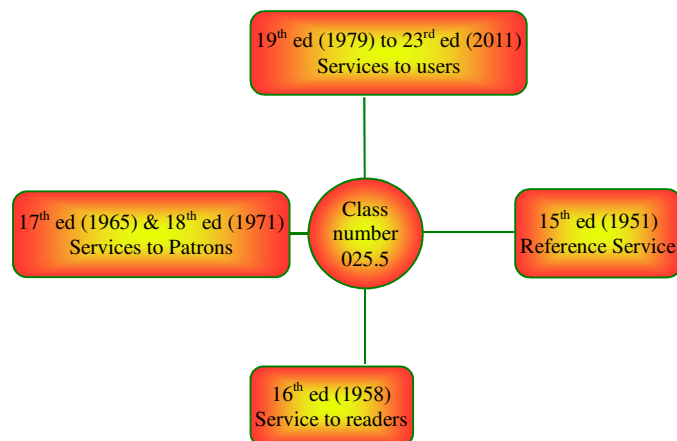

The above figure 1.1 is shows that edition wise changes has been occurred.

The first and noticeable change is class number 025 changing its title edition wise. For example: In the 15th rev. ed (1952) the title is 'Administration' which 16th ed (1958) followed by 'Library Management and Operations' again its change to 'Library economy' in 17th ed (1965). 'Library operations' is term set for 18th (1971) and 19th (1979). 'Archives and information centres' have been accommodated in 20th to 23rd editions in additions to Operations of libraries.



The above figure 1.2 is shows that edition wise changes has been occurred in terminologies

Class number 025.5 changing its terms edition wise. For example: In the 15th ed (1951) the term is 'Reference service' which is 16th ed (1958) accommodated with 'Service to readers' again its change to 'Services to patrons' in 17th ed (1965) & 18th ed (1971). 'Services to users' is a term set for 19th (1979) and 23rd (2011).

Observations

025 was ‘Administration’ in 15th edition, which was reframed as ‘Library management and operation’ in the 16th edition. in 17th edition it was renamed as ‘Library economy’, which again was changed as ‘Library operations’ in 18th edition that continued for 19th edition too. From 20th onward it was termed as 'operations of libraries,archives and information centers'

'Administration' term has become a part of(025.1) from 17th edition onward and wider term is operation of libraries, achieves and information centers which still prevalent today

has been used, Achieves and information centers were adapted from 20th edition onward.

025.02 to 025.078 has five subdivision. 025.01, 025.03, 025.05, 025.08, 025.09 are still unassigned. 025.02 was allotted to technical process in 17th edition which unchanged till 23rd edition. Concept of information storage and retrieval was added first time in 19th edition to 025.04 which narrower terms were assigned in the latest edition i.e. 23rd. Concept of www, websites, search engines and semantic web became part of ISRS. In the 19th edition itself 'ISRS devoted to specific subjects' was assigned with the class number 025.06 its a narrower term 'Geography and travel' was added in 23rd edition. 025.078 was the class number for 'Instruments and apparatus' which open only in 16th edition. Since then this number is not allotted to any term.

025.1 is been assigned to 'Executive and general management' in 16th edition which was renamed as 'Administration' from 17th edition onward. 025.1 has six subdivision, 025.13, 025.14, 025.16 are not allotted. 025.11 is the 'finance' since 15th edition and is unchanged till 23rd edition.

025.12 was assigned to 'Printing and Publication' from 15th to 19th edition which was re-termed as 'Duplication services'(Reprography) from 20th edition onward. 'Printing and publication' as 'Duplication process in library' as narrower term from 15th to 19th edition. This class number was discontinued from 19th edition as it replaced the 'concept of printing and publication'

from 20th edition onward. 025.15 was allotted to term 'correspondence' only in 16th edition.

025.17 is been assigned to 'treatment of special materials' from 15th to 19th edition, which was renamed as 'administration of collection of special materials' in 20th edition onward. 025.171 has three subdivisions, 025.171.2, 025.171.4, 025.171.6 are not allotted any term till 18th edition, then it assigned same class number in the 19th edition as 'manuscript, archival materials and Rarities. 025.172 has been assigned to 'pamphlets' in the 15th and 16th editions and changed to 'vertical files' in the 17th edition which was added two more term as 'clippings, broadsides' in the 18th and 19th edition. This class numbers was discontinue from the 20th edition onward because it comes under broader term 'administration of collection of special materials.

025.173 also have three subdivisions, 025.173.2, 025.173.4, 025.173.6 are not allotted any term till 18th edition. 025.173 was allotted to 'Serials, Documents' in two consecutive editions i.e. 15th & 16th. The term 'report literature' has been added in 17th edition, also renamed documents to government publication in 19th edition and all got unassigned from the 20th edition onward.

025.174 has assigned term 'Broadsides' only in the 16th edition. 025.176 has been framed to 'map' in the 15th edition and added 'charts' in 16th edition also assigned new term 'globe' in the 17th to 19th edition. The class got discontinued from 20th edition

025.177 has been adapted to 'art materials' in the 15th edition, which was renamed as 'audio visual materials' from 16th to 18th edition and again it is re-termed as ' pictures and materials for projection' from 20th edition. The term 'art materials' is subdivision of 'audio visual materials' become narrower term in 17th edition of class 025.177.1, and it is changed to 'pictures and prints' in the next two consecutive editions. The term 'films and slides has assigned in the 17th and 18th edition of class 025.177.3 and reframed as 'motion pictures, filmstrip & slides' in the 19th edition. 025.177 got discontinued from 20th edition.

025.178 has been assigned the term 'music' in the 15th & 16th editions and added 'recorded and music scores' in the 17th and 18th editions, it has two subdivision i.e., 025.178.2 & 025.178.4. It assigned 'sound recording & music score in 19th edition.

025.179 has been allotted the term 'other special material' from 15th to 19th editions with adding three subdivisions as 025.179.2 assigned term 'book in raised character' in 17th to 19th editions and two more subdivision 025.179.4 & 025.171.6 are assigned to 'microform' and 'games, models, media, kits' respectively in the 19th edition only.

Class number 025.17 has been added twenty three subdivisions in the 15th to 19th editions and re-framed entire 025.17 into one division namely 'administration of collection of special materials' in 20th edition onward.

025.19 has been introduced from the 19th edition to 23rd edition for the term 'administration of special types of institutions'.

025.2 has been assigned to 'Acquisitions' from 15th to 18th ed which was renamed as 'Acquisition and collection development' from 19th edition onwards. It means collections development started in 1979 in library science and continue upto 23rd edition.

The term 'book selection process' and 'method of acquisition' has been given to class number 025.21 and 025.22 in 15th and 16th editions. 025.213 has been allotted the term 'censorship' from 19th edition onwards, similarly 025.216 assigned to 'weeding'. 025.218 assigned to 'selection in specific type of libraries' in 19th edition, it changed to 'collection development in specific types of institutions' in 20th edition onward, which are narrower terminologies of 'book selection process'.

025.23 has been termed 'ordering and receiving' in 16th edition and re-named as a 'order work' in 17th and 18th edition, which was changed to 'acquisition through purchase' in 19th to 23rd editions. 025.23 has two subdivision, first one is 025.233 which was started from 19th edition and termed as 'library relation with vendors' it removed the word 'library' and set it as 'relation with vendors' in 20th edition onward and second one is 025.236 allocated the term 'clerical operations' from 19th to 23rd editions.

025.24 has been set a term 'accessioning' in 17th edition which was discontinued from 18th edition ahead.

025.25 has been allotted to 'ownership marks and physical preparation for shelves' in 16th edition, where it has been changed to 'physical preparation for shelves' in 17th edition, and it become 'physical preparation for storage' in 18th and 19th editions, which is discontinued the same term and shifted to 025.7.

025.26 has been given a term 'exchange and gift work' from 16th to 18th editions and it is re-termed as a ' acquisition through exchange, gift, deposit' in 19th edition to 23rd edition.

025.27 class number has allocated to the 'selection and acquisition of materials on specific subjects' in 19th edition, where it has been added the word 'collection development' and term represent as ' collection development and acquisition of materials on specific disciplines and subjects' in 20th edition, which again was changed to 'acquisition of and collection development for materials on specific subjects' in 21st edition onward.

025.28 has been assigned to 'selection and acquisition of materials in special forms in 19th edition and re-framed it as 'collection development for and acquisition of materials in special forms' in 20th edition. 'Acquisition of and collection development for materials on specific forms' term given in 21st to 23rd editions. It has one subdivision with class numbered 025.284.4 which has introduced a new term as a 'selection and acquisition of materials from various specific

places in 19th edition, which was discontinued from 20th to 22nd editions and again renamed as 'acquisition of and collection development for archival materials' in 23rd edition.

025.29 has been set a term 'acquisition of special materials' in 16th edition, which was removed from the 17th to 19th edition, and referred as 'collection development for and acquisition of materials from geographic areas' in 20th editions onward.

025.3 have forty five subdivisions. The term 'cataloguing' has been adopted in 025.3, which was assigned for the 15th to 18th edition and it has changed to 'bibliographic analysis and control' from the 19th to 23rd edition. It has been observe that the use of computer application was growing in library and added in 20th edition, which was published in 1996. And that is why they added the term 'application of computer data representation, record format, preparation etc.

025.302.85 has been given a term 'data processing and computer application' in 21st edition, whereas class number 025.302.855.72 assigned in 20th edition to the same subjects. It means subdivision has been taken before its earlier hierarchies. The term 'application of computer data files and databases' are added in 025.302.855.74 in from 20th to 22nd edition, which is reframed as 'data files and databases' in the next edition. 025.302.855.74 has two subdivision, which starting from 21st editions and termed as application of file organization and access method', it got renamed in 23rd edition as 'file organization and access method' in class number

025.302.855.741 and the term 'application of computer sorting' in class number 025.302.855.748.

025.31 class started from the 19th edition onward with the term 'The catalog' where earlier it was allotted in 025.3 in 15th to 18th edition. The term 'form' newly added which is narrower term of 'the catalog', there was extended the hierarchies of 025.313 to 025.313.2, which is assigned to 'online catalogs' in 20th to 23rd edition.

The Terminology 'Machine-readable catalog record format' brings in 20th edition onward and allocate to 025.316 to understand the cataloging records format to the classifier. 025.317 has been given the term 'maintenance' in 19th edition and adding the word 'conversion' in the next edition i.e 20th edition ahead, term became a 'conversion and maintenance'. It has two narrower term and framed as 'retrospective conversion' and the second one is as 'filing' with notations 025.317.3 and 025.317.7 for the same editions.

025.32 has been allocated to the 'rules' in 15th edition, which is re-termed as a 'cataloging rules' in the next edition, it again was changed to 'descriptive cataloging' in 17th to 23rd editions. 025.322 was allotted to 'choice of entry and forms of heading' from the 19th edition onward and added one narrower term as 'name and title authority file' where it was discontinued for 21st and 22nd edition, it again was brought in 23rd edition as a 'authority file'. The term 'bibliographic description' has been given to 025.324, which comes under 'descriptive cataloging'.

025.33 was allotted to the term 'subject heading' in 15th and 16th edition and renamed as a 'subject cataloging' in 17th to 19th editions, which was shifted from 025.33 to 025.47 in 20th edition onward.

025.34 has been given to 'cataloging of special materials' in 15th to 18th editions, then it added the term 'classification' and 'indexing' and renamed as 'cataloging, classification, indexing of special materials' from 19th edition onward. There are so many new terminologies has been introduced from the 20th to 23rd editions for the same class number, which have listed below.

The term 'machine-readable materials' has been introduced in 20th editions but it was discontinued for two consecutive editions i.e 21st and 22nd and again it was brought in 23rd editions as a 'electronic resources for the same class number.

It has been observed that most of the terminologies were newly introduced from the 20th edition onward.

025.35 has started with the 'cooperative efforts' in 15th edition, which renamed as 'cooperative cataloging' till 18th edition and added 'classification' in 19th edition and again it is changed as 'cooperative cataloging, classification and indexing from 20th to 23rd edition.

025.37 has been assigned to 'filing' in the 15th to 18th edition and it has been shifted to 025.317 from 19th edition onward.

025.39 has two subdivision, which are 025.393 and 025.396 with the term 'recataloging and reclassification'. 025.39 has the term 'recataloging' in 18th edition and added reindexing in 19th edition ahead. The term 'recataloging' shifted to subdivision i.e. 025.393 from 19th

edition to 22 edition also for 025.396 it remain 'reclassification' same terms discontinue in 23rd edition for both subdivisions.

025.4 has been allotted to 'classification' til 18th edition and changed to 'subject analysis and control' form 19th to 23rd edition. 025.402.8 assigned to the term 'techniques and procedures apparatus, equipment, materials in 19th edition and added with 'abstracting techniques; auxiliary techniques in 20th edition also discontinue 'abstracting techniques' in the next editions i.e 21st. It is introduced separately with new class number 025.41 in the 23rd edition. It has been newly assigned the term 'computer application' and 'natural language processing' under the abstracting.

025.42 assigned a term 'classification' in 19th edition, which was already assigned to class 025.4 from 15th to 18th edition. 025.428 introduced a new term 'shelflisting' in 20th edition and 23rd edition, but it was discontinue in 21st and 22nd edition.

025.43 has five subdivision 025.431,025.432,025.433,025.434,025.435. The term 'classification schedule' given in the 16th edition, it has been changed to 'general classification schedule' in 17th and 18th edition, then has renamed as 'general classification system' from 19th edition onward. It has observed that classification system introduced from 19th edition

with name like DDC, UDC, LCC. CC etc. earlier it came under general classification system.

025.46 has assigned to 'classification of special subject' till 17th edition and added 'disciplines' and reframed it as 'classification of specific disciplines and subject' from 18th to 20th ed. It has been removed from 21st to 22nd edition, surprisingly again it started with the term 'classification of specific subject' in 23rd edition.

025.47 introduced the term 'subject cataloging' from 19th to 22nd edition and renamed as 'subject indexing and cataloging in 23rd edition.

'Subject indexing' term earlier was in 025.48 class, it was inherited from class 025.47 23rd edition and the same term changed to 'subject cataloging and indexing schemes in specific language' in same edition.

Schemes of indexing systems expanded in next hierarchy and produced the term as 'precoordinate' 025.482 renamed as 'coordinate and postcoordinate' for 025.484 from 19th to 23rd edition. The term 'title manipulation' added for 025.486 in 19th to 22nd edition and it has been changed as a 'full-text indexing' in 23rd edition. Newly produced a term 'tagging' in 23rd edition for 025.487, which is narrower term of 'subject cataloging and indexing schemes in specific language'.

025.49 class number assigned 'reclassification' in 18th ed. And replaced with 'controlled subject vocabularies' in 19th to 22nd ed. Again it has changed to 'subject cataloging and indexing of specific subject in 23rd edition.

025.5 has been given a term 'reference service' in 15th ed., which was reframed as services to readers' in 16th ed. In 17th and 18th ed. it was renamed as 'service to patrons', which again changed as 'services to user' from 19th ed onward. 'Reference service' became a narrower term of 'services to readers' whereas earlier it was broader term.

In class 025.52 introduced the term 'reference service' for 16th and 17th edition , which has been changed in 18th ed onward as a 'reference and information services. The word 'information' came from the 18th ed in library science schedule. It shows that the importance of information understand form the 1971 in library science.

025.523 has been allotted to 'cooperative information services', 025.524 was assigned to 'information search and retrieval', 025.525 assigned to 'selective dissemination of information' and 025.527 class number given to 'reference and information services in specific types of libraries. It noticed that from 19th to 23rd ed are same terminologies allotted to the respective class number as given in the above paragraph.

025.54 assigned 'adult reader service' in the 16th ed and reframed it as a 'reader advisory services' in the next two consecutive edition has two subdivision in the same editions, one is for 'to individuals' and other one is 'to group' in the class number 025.542 and 025.543 respectively. Again it has merged into 025.54 and set the term as 'reader advisory services to individuals and group' from 19th to 23rd ed.

025.56 has been assigned the term 'library orientation' in 19th ed and renamed as 'bibliographic instruction for users' from 20th ed onward. 025.58 has been allotted to 'library user studies' from 19th ed. till 23rd edition

025.6 is the only class number has nothing changed in the 15th to 23rd ed, which was termed as 'circulation services'. The term 'Interlibrary loan' has been added from 19th to 23rd ed for class number 025.62.

025.7 class number allocated to 'binding and repair' in 15th ed, it was renamed as 'book binding and book repair' in the next edition, once again it has been renamed as 'binding and repair services' in 17th and 18th ed, which again was replaced with a 'physical preparation for storage' in 19th ed. and reframed with minor changes in earlier term and set it as 'physical preparation and storage use' in 20th edition onward.

The term 'arrangement, preservation' comes under 025.8 in the 15th ed and 'book arrangement and preservation' in the next edition, which was re-termed as 'maintenance and preservation of collection' from the 17th ed onward. 025.8 has

three subdivisions which are divided into 025.81, 025.82 and 025.84. The term 'arrangement' assigned to 025.81 in 17th and 18th ed where earlier it was in 025.8 in the 15th ed. It has been replaced with the 'physical arrangement and access to collection' in 19th ed onward. Same thing happened with 025.82 as 'inventory' available in three editions i.e 16th, 17th and 18th ed, where it has been changed as a 'security against theft and other hazards' from 19th ed onward. The term 'preservation' has been given in 025.84 from 16th to 18th ed and removed from 19th to 22nd ed, which was again added in 23rd edition. It seems like we need the terminologies when we classify the book and that is why they added.

025.9 has three term that is 'janitorial and maintenance service' in 16th ed and 'maintenance of physical plant' in 17th and 18th ed which was removed from 19th ed onward.

Conclusion

The classification experts spend most of the time to analysis and finding suitable and appropriate class number to the subject. The above study shows that time to time need to change the subject priorities according to universe of knowledge. OCLC and DC Editorial Policy Committee and the European Dewey Users Group (EDUG) in keeping the DDC update. But we need to expand more and more terminologies where classifier get easy to use perfect class number to the subject.
